





Chateau Lafont Fourcat 2017

80% Merlot, 15% Malbec, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES:

This wine has a meaty nose with ripe dark fruits and some punchy oak impact. It follows to the palate with attractive tannins that hold dark berry flavors long and fresh.







Chateau Larose-Trintuadon 2015

45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 48% Merlot, 7% Petit Verdot

TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful dark ruby color with quite an intense bouquet bringing together aromas or red ripe berries as well as spicier vanilla notes. On the palate the wine is incredibly round with a dense tannic structure, yet not overly massive. Great freshness finished off by slight mineral undertones and a silky texture.







Chateau Pey de Pont 2015


50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 50% Merlot

TASTING NOTES:

A beautiful Bordeaux from the left bank showcasing rich cassis, sandlewood, vanilla and toast from the oak influence. Beautiful bright red color with a very open nose with chocolate notes and ripe black fruits, with eucalyptus perfumes. It is balanced, structured, round and has a full mouth, with a long and aromatic finish.







Chateau Les Millaux 2016

80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc

TASTING NOTES:

Lovely dark red color with a dark purple reflection. Pleasant smells come from plum, blackcurrant, and some spices. In the mouth the wine has a full-bodied richness with a subtle freshness.







Close Pichot 2018

60% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Franc

TASTING NOTES:

This dark colored blend reveals aromas of blackberry and cherry subtly intermixed with floral notes of violets. Great purity on the palate is followed by fine and silky tannins, with a long, mineral finish.







Chateau Jalousie Beaulieu 2017

83% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc, 7% Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES:

The fruit is right up front in this ripe, full wine. With fine tannins and a rich texture, it is spicy, toasty and packed with blackberry fruits. Acidity shows strongly at the end.
